Dear Parents,

We have had a great Fall session of Day Program and evening programs! Thank you to everyone who participated in activities this Fall. Enclosed are the details for our upcoming programs and activities for Spring 2019. Please read through the notes below and take a look at the program descriptions to see what fun and educational activities are being offered this session.

Space is limited in each program, so we ask that you please submit your registration form and payment as soon as possible to secure a spot. Programs will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. For questions about availability, please contact Kayle. Note, this session we are putting a minimum amount of participants for each program. We are requiring that each program have at least 5 participants signed up. We will let you know one week prior if we have not met the minimum required. This allows us to maximize our resources.

All participants must be registered for a program in order to attend. Programs have size restrictions and in order for us to adequately staff each activity, we must know who is attending ahead of time. We ask that you please fill out and submit the Registration Packet, along with your payment, prior to the start of programs.

Classes that serve a meal increased to \$12. All other programs will stay \$5 for preregistered participants and increase to \$7 for walk-ins. The cutoff date is February 28th.

In order to ensure the safety of our program participants, we require that individuals who need 1-on-1 assistance to please come with a guardian or aide. If your participant is unable to attend a program, we ask that you call at least 24 hours in advanced to receive reimbursement.

Dear Parents,

We promote a healthy and safe environment at Hannah & Friends Neighborhood. We want all participants and their families to feel secure. There are three major activities that take place on our grounds excluding the residential homes which are run by Logan. We have evening activities including dances, karaoke, and many more that are held throughout the year. We have our summer camp that is held exclusively in the summer. We have our Day Programs which will run throughout the year. We are very excited about all of these activities.

We have a clear policy on "bullying" for the protection of all participants, workers, and volunteers. Simply stated it reads

"Hannah & Friends Neighborhood has a three strikes rule when it comes to bullying and bad behavior. The first time this happens, the individual will be written up and the family will be notified of the infraction. The second time this happens, the individual will be written up and the family will be contacted to come pick him/her up not returning for any activities the rest of the day. Both the participant and the family will be informed that a third infraction will lead to dismissal from all programs at Hannah & Friends Neighborhood. There is only one exception. If at any time, an infraction is serious, the individual can be dismissed immediately."

This policy exists to protect everyone and support our mission where those with "Different Abilities" can have a neighborhood where they are treated truly special.
